Non-Union Craft Tuition Reimbursement

Please share some of the highlights of the program. See page 2 for more details of the program. We recognize this benefit is not available to all of the crew now since they may not have 3 years of service, but it will be available to them when they attain 3 years of service.

Highlights:

- Mortenson is adding a new benefit for non-union craft team members to receive reimbursement for completed classes to continue your education.
- Eligible team members are full-time non-union craft with combined service of 3 years or greater.
- Benefit is available now and began on January 1, 2021!
- Level of reimbursement varies based on type of degree:
 - Technical or Associate up to \$1,000 annually (\$5,000 lifetime maximum)
 - Undergraduate up to \$3,000 annually (\$15,000 lifetime maximum)
 - o Graduate up to \$5,000 annually (\$25,000 lifetime maximum)

Tuition Reimbursement Program:

Eligibility

In order to be eligible, team members must meet the requirements below:

- Full-time (40 hours / week)
- Non-Union
- Combined service of over 3 years
- Employment in good standing (not on a performance improvement plan)

Benefit

Eligible Programs and Degrees:

- Must be completed at an accredited trades school, college, or university
- Pursuing a type of degree that is applicable to current or future employment at Mortenson (nursing, art history would be ineligible, engineering, electrical, engineering, accounting, would be eligible)
- In certain circumstances, Approved Certificates from an Eligible Educational Institute

Reimbursement amount varies based on the type of degree:

- Technical or Associate up to \$1,000 annually (\$5,000 lifetime maximum)
- Undergraduate up to \$3,000 annually (\$15,000 lifetime maximum)
- Graduate up to \$5,000 annually (\$25,000 lifetime maximum)

Eligible Expenses: Tuition, registration fees, and books

Steps to Apply and Receive Reimbursement

- Team member will need to complete the <u>Tuition Reimbursement Application</u> (also available on mycraftbenefits.com). Completed form should be sent (email if possible) to their Superintendent & Field Operations Manager for approval
- 2. Submit approved Tuition Reimbursement Application to askHR@mortenson.com
- 3. Complete the coursework with a passing grade, minimum of C or better
- 4. Submit a <u>Tuition Reimbursement Form</u>, with supporting documentation of payment and completion with a passing grade

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
